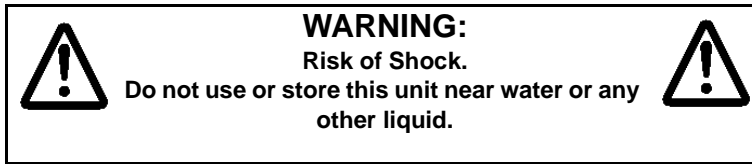


Plug In Residential Rechargeable Flashlight



IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. All servicing should be performed by qualified service personnel.
2. Remove unit from wall socket before servicing or cleaning.
3. Do not use outdoors.
4. Do not mount near gas or electric heaters.
5. To reduce the risk of injury, close supervision is necessary when the unit is being used near children.
6. The use of accessory equipment not recommended by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
7. Do not use this equipment for other than intended use.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

Installation Instructions

1. Rotate the unit power plug with your fingers so that the plug sticks out 90 degrees (see fig 1).
2. Insert the unit power plug into a wall socket (see fig 2).
3. Turn the switch to the on position (see fig. 3).
4. When the AC supply is on, the LED charge indicator shows red. Press the test button, the LED heads will turn on and the LED indicator will turn off. Release the test button, the LED indicator will turn on and the LED heads will turn off (see fig. 3).
5. When the AC supply has been disrupted the unit will turn on.
6. If the AC supply has been disrupted and the light from the unit is not required the switch can be turned to the off position.
7. If the unit is to be used as a flashlight. Remove the unit from the wall socket, rotate the power plug back into the opening and turn on the switch if not already on.

Trouble Shooting Guide

If the LED heads or LED indicator does not illuminate, check the following:

1. Check AC supply - verify that unit has 24 hour AC supply.
2. Unit has shorted or battery is not connected.
3. Battery discharged. Permit unit to charge for 24 hours or 48 hours (for units with 2 batteries) and then re-test.
4. If above trouble shooting hints do not solve your problem, contact customer service for assistance.

Maintenance

None required. Replace the batteries as needed according to ambient conditions. We recommend that the equipment be tested regularly to ensure proper operation.

Comes standard with (1) one year warranty.
